
- Panzer Dragoon Saga (Saturn)

- And more!


Now I don't really know that much about video games, but what I do know is Ebay and the science of collecting. While watching "Antiques Roadshow" a few years ago, I got clued into the fact that video games were the next big collector's market and I decided to get in big. Before starting this collection, I researched what brought top dollar on Ebay, and it occurred to me that the games that brought in top dollar were the ones that had their [original shrinkwrap](#). In fact it didn't seem to matter if the games were good or bad, [it was the shrinkwrap that counted](#) - so that's why I started my collection with these beauties.....



That's right...over the last few years, I've put together what may be the largest collection of original shrinkwrap from the rarest video games in the world. And while I've found a few on my own, my source (I'll call him "Joe") has been able to get me the packaging for almost any game I desire. He says he runs a video game website, but even so, his ability to get me any title I want (almost instantly!) has been amazing. And the man is a professional...everything Joe sells me comes with documentation of authenticity....




Every item pictured here comes with similar paperwork (although sometimes the paper used is a bit different - one is on the back of a beer bottle label I think, but the signature is always verified to be the same!). The close working relationship we have developed has paid off handsomely, allowing me to pick up some of the rarest vintage items ever released. And now you can own them for yourself....



Please note the damage on the Eli's Ladder packaging, I know how important condition is to collectors, and I do not want to take advantage of anyone. Lord knows you've got to watch out for the sharks who will take advantage of clueless people. Speaking of taking advantage, Joe sold me a lot of unidentified items, he realized (too late, ha ha!) were actually prototypes for an unreleased 2600 game....



From what I have learned, the value of these prototypes lies in the fact that they are all slightly different, leading up to the final production package. Joe's still checking, but he thinks these items may be from the rumored 2600 game "Doom". If you win this auction you may have an undiscovered find on your hands! Then again, you'll definitely have at least 3 one-of-a-kinds with these unique items I'm sweetening the pot with....



This Crazy Climber was sealed sideways, putting the shrinkwrap seams on the LONG sides of the box ...unbelievably rare! Next is the only known to exist packaging for a game there were only 20 copies made of to begin with! Unfortunately, the rarity of this item led the previous owner to try to shrinkwrap it, for protection. Even with the obvious damage, this item is priceless! And finally, the original packaging from the developer's copy of a game called "Beat 'Em & Eat ' Em". This was a tough one to get a hold of! It was in Joe's personal collection and he wouldn't let go of it! But I kept jacking up the price and he finally came around.

As I said before, each item in this auction comes with documentation from my supplier. **I will require all bidders to acknowledge this documentation as proof of authenticity before any bids will be accepted.** Please E-mail me to request the acknowledgement forms. Due to the environmentally controlled shipping required for these items (I once left a 2600 River
